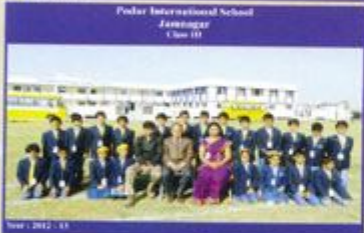


## Birthday Celebration
