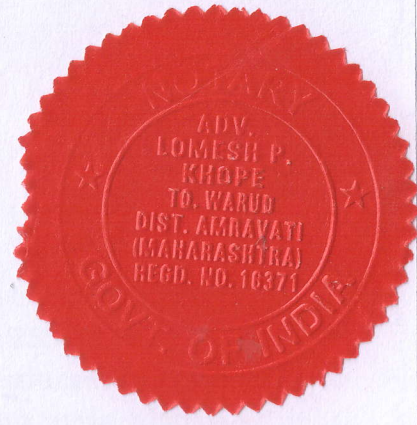

On the basis of the correspondence with the school/ inspection of the school in regards of your application dt.27.06.2019,

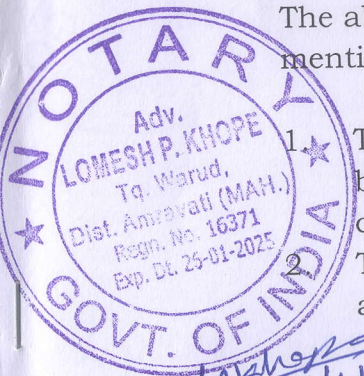

The abovementioned recognition is subject to the compliance of the terms mentioned below:

1. The period of recognition shall not be extended and it will not be binding to grant recognition or affiliation in any situation or circumstance after standard 8th.

The school will abide by the provisions of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (Annexure 1) and of Right of

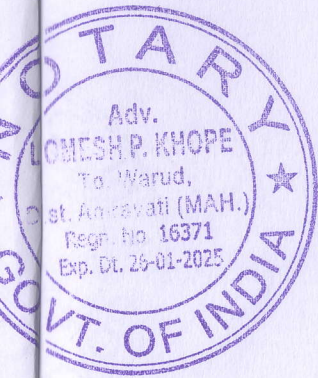

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Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 (Annexure 2).

3. The school will provide admission to nearby weaker sections and deprived groups in standard 1 (class 1) to the extent of 25% of total number of students and provide free and compulsory education to them till the completion of their primary education but it is also stated that the above direction shall be followed/implemented in regards pre-primary education also.
4. For the children mentioned in clause no. 3 above the school will be provided with reimbursement as per the provisions of section 12(2) of the act abovementioned for the fulfilment of which the school will be provided with a separate and independent bank account.
5. The school will not recover and kind of capitation fee and shall not compel to any child or his parents or his guardians for any kind of scrutiny process.
6. No child should be, in the absence of proof of age, denied admission in the school on the basis of religion, caste or lineage, place of birth or any of the said reasons.
7. **(One)** A child who has been admitted in the school should not be withheld in the same class (standard) in which he might be or he should not be expelled from the school until the completion of his primary education.
8. **(Two)** No child should be subjected to any kind of mental or physical harassment.
(Three) No child shall be required to pass any board examination until completion of his primary education.
(Four) Every child who has completed it's primary education shall be awarded with certificate as determined in rule 23.
(Five) Specially abled children shall be included/admitted as per the provisions of the act.
(Six) Candidates having minimum qualification as prescribed by the provision of section 23(1) of the act shall be appointed as teachers. Also the teachers not possessing the said minimum qualification will have a span of 5 years to obtain the said qualification.
(Seven) The Teacher shall fulfil and comply with his/her duties and responsibilities as prescribed by section 24(1) of the Act.
(Eight) The School shall ensure that the teachers are not engaged in the work of private tuitions.
9. The schools shall comply with the teaching course as prepared on the basis of syllabus prescribed by the competent authority.
10. The school shall, as per the provisions of section 19 of the act, admit students keeping in mind the facilities available in the school.

11. The school shall comply with the standards and norms as specified in section 19 of the act.

At the time of last inspection the following facilities were available in the school:-

- The area of the school premises - 8782 sq. m.
- Total built-up area - 2997 sq. m.
- Area of the play ground - 6224 sq. m.
- Total number of classrooms - 25 classrooms
- Office, store room and chamber of principal- In existence
- Separate toilets for girls and boys having sufficient water for use, cleaning the toilets and keeping them sanitised.- In existence
- Facility for drinking water - In existence
- Kitchen for cooking midday meal- N.A.
- Availability of teaching learning materials/sports and sports related accessories/library- In existence
- Availability of reading material- In existence

12. School shall not be able to run classes or sections not having recognition in the name of the school in the premises of the school or otherwise.

13. The building of the school or other construction or the playground shall be used only for the purpose of educational and skilled development.

14. The school is being run through organisation which is either registered under The Societies Registration Act, 1860 or under Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950.

15. The school shall not be run for the purpose of gaining profits or for the benefit of any particular person, group or association of people.

16. School accounts should be audited and certified by a chartered accountant and appropriate account statements should be prepared as per the rules. One copy of each audit statement should be sent to the District Education Officer every year.

17. The recognition code (number) received by your school is 27070205605, this code should be mentioned while doing any kind of correspondence with this office.

18. The school should submit appropriate report and information as demanded by The Director of Education/District Education Officer OR for the purpose of continuous fulfilment of the terms of recognition of the school or for the purpose of eliminating errors coming in day to day business of the school, the school shall comply with the instructions so given by the Government or Local Authorities.
