


Editor's Desk

The Principal, Mrs Anagha Gholap reminded the council that with position comes responsibility. She advised them to be the role models. The function concluded with 'Vande Mataram'.

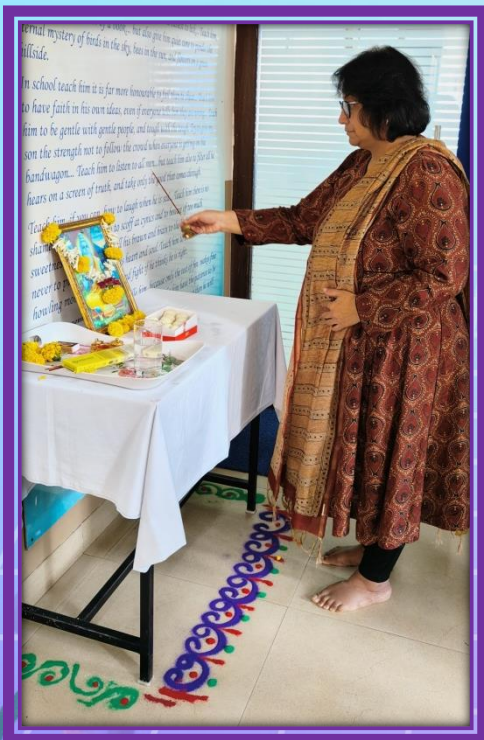


GURU PURNIMA

MIRROR MUSINGS

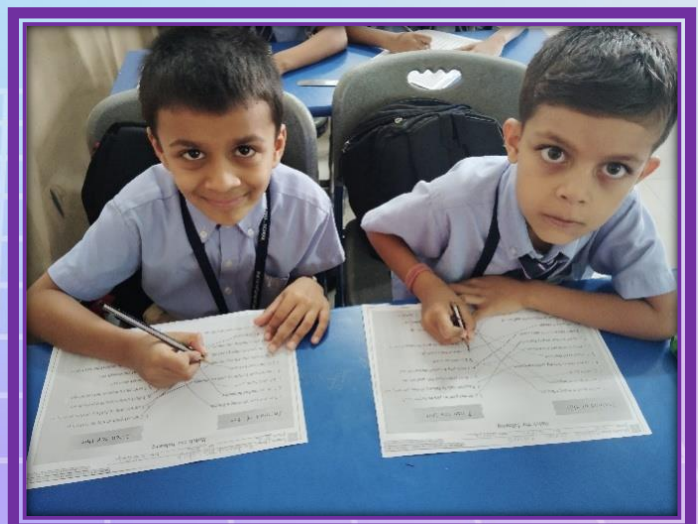
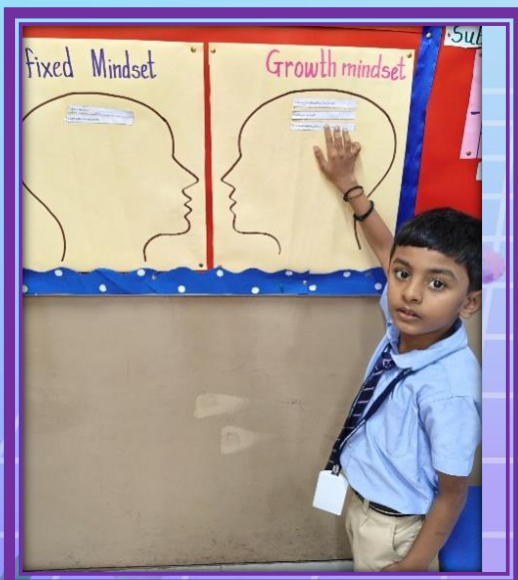
Date: 20 July 2024

JUMPSTART ACTIVITY

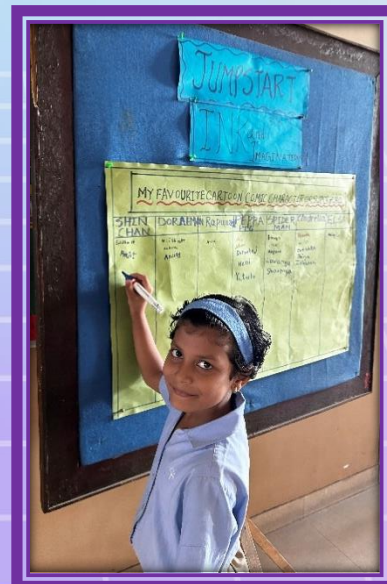
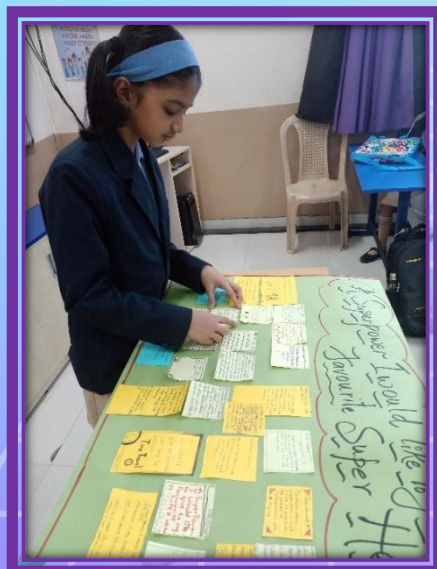
Date: 23 July 2024

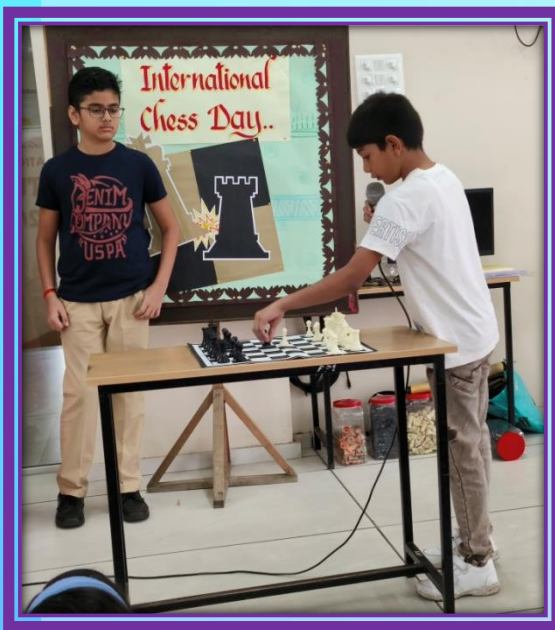


WORLD CHESS DAY
