Theme: Plastic Plastic Everywhere

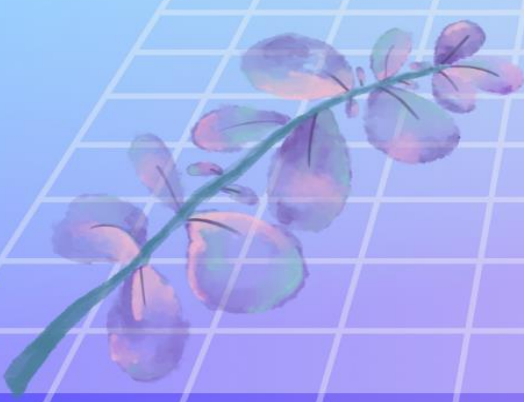
Saying No to Plastic is,
