

The second meeting of the EPTA was held on 21 September, 2024 at 8.00 am in the school Library.

Principal Madam commenced the meeting by welcoming all the members of the EPTA.

The meeting proceeded as per the Agenda points:

Points of discussion as per the Agenda points were as follows:

### 1) <u>Review of Term 1:</u>

• Principal Madam discussed the important programmes which were incorporated in Term I,briefed the members about the academic goals and their achievements in Term I and explained the School Development Plan (SDP).

### 2) Approving the Fee Structure for the AY 2025-26:

- Principal Madam explained the fee hike structure from the AY 2017 onwards.
- She explained all the government circulars regarding fee hike criteria and informed the members that the school has followed all the rules related to it.
- The Government circulars were presented in the meeting for the members' reference.
- The new fee structure for the AY 2025-26 was presented in the meeting and all the members approved and signed it unanimously after discussions and deliberations.

#### **Resolution 1:**

*Resolved that fee hike of 14.9% for the AY 2025-26 has been unanimously approved and passed by the members of the ECPTA.*

#### 3) <u>Strict paper correction in Std. IX:</u>

- Principal Madam informed the members that the correction is done as per the Marking Scheme sent by Podar Innovation Centre. This is not only for Std. IX but all the classes from Std. III to Std. X.
- She also explained that the difference is felt by the parents of Std. IX as the passing criteria are different for std. IX. They have separate passing (minimum 33.33%) in internal as well as external examination as per the board criteria. This is informed to all the parents in the Orientation programme and an undertaking is also signed by all of them.
- Till Std. VIII internal and external marks are calculated together.
- Also, for the reference of all parents, exam writing instructions have been sent to all classes in the HYE examination. Students must write the paper as per the instructions or marks will be deducted.

### <u>Resolution 2:</u>

### Resolved that-

- a) Answer scripts for all classes are corrected as per the Marking Scheme provided by Podar Innovation Centre.
- b) Instructions to write the paper have been sent to the students of Std. IX and X at the beginning of the year.

#### 4) <u>Attendance of the students:</u>

Principal Madam informed the members that students must have minmum 75% attendance in IX and X Std. Otherwise registration to the AISSE Examination cannot be done.

## Resolution 3:

#### Resolved that -

- a) 75% attendance is mandatory for Std. IX and X as per the CBSE Rule.
- b) If the student does not have 75% attendance in Std. X, registration of that student is not possible and will not be done by school.

Other points discussed were- Measures of girls' safety in school, break time for the students, recycling of paper in school and weight of the school bag.
